August 14, 1935

Outcrop of coal in road, south side of E-W tributary. About 10' above bed of gully. Shaly underclay, shale above coal. Coal Measures 38"-40".

Thin $(\frac{1}{2}")$ clay band 4" above base of bed.


Probably coal No.7

1831.8c

August 14, 1935

House at this point.

Coal said to outcrop over crest of hill north in road. Old mine (75 years old) sunk 50' or 60' to 42" coal bed. At spot indicated below. This location not checked.
