November 23, 1930

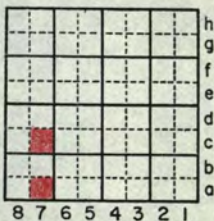
Abandoned mine. Above bottom 10'-20'. 150 yards north of east-west Sec. line road. Probably mined #2.

Reported worked out.

0115.7c

November 23, 1930

Abandoned mine on side of ravine 200 yards ± east of road. South of house 150'±. 19' to bottom of coal with slate roof. Thickness of coal 20-32". Coal sold at mine for \$3.00 per ton. **Operated forty years**. Now worked out. Reported clay fault cutting out coal before reaching sec. line road to west. **Shaft** reported to have gone through ("soapstone"). Elevation surface 530± Coal 511±. Probably mined #2.

November 23, 1930

Elevation Ruhle house 610'+

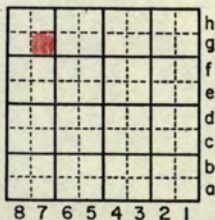
Elevation bottom of Little Apple Creek at foot of bluff just east of Ruhle house 550 rock

No outcrops in this area. Covered with over 65' of drift. Interpolated elevation of (2 ?) 510'. Mine about 3 miles south and half mile west encounters coal at 511'. If there is no marked change in dip the coal should be encountered at a depth of 40-50 feet in this bottom.
