B1 Campbell's bank. North side of SW/4 NE/4 Sec.30.
 Bank about 1/8 mile east of N-S road. Bench mark
 by house 544.
 Elevation of bottom of coal 518. A.T.L."
 Previously examined and limestone collected for
 fossils.
 Coal 5' thick with blue shale and limestone above.
 Blue bank 2'-0 [sic] thick. 8" above base.
 Fireclay below. General Coal Report #512.

B2 Jackson's bank. NE/4 SW/4 Sec.30.
 Bench mark 577.
 Elevation of top of fireclay below coal 544 A.T.L.
 Bottom of coal not definitely found.
 General Coal Report #528.

B3 Edward's bank. (W.F. Edwards) in SW corner of Sec.
 30 about 1/8 mile north of south and 100-150 yards
 east of west line.
 Coal about 4' thick along eroded edge. Probably
 will increase in thickness toward the hill.
 Elevation 480 A.T.L.
 Bench mark by Edward's house 530.
 Condition and altitude of outcrop led me to suspect
 this to be a lower coal than #7. No limestone seen.
 General Coal Report #530.
