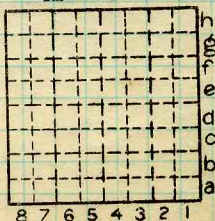

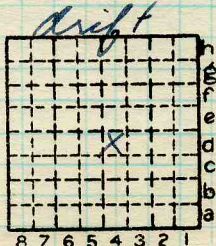

 ILLINOIS GEOLOGICAL SURVEY, URBANA



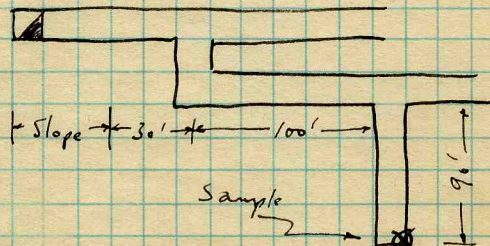
