Coal 2'2" - 2'6" locally down to 1'


Shale roof

Strip 18' overburden - 6' shale, rest gravel

Spring Lake Coal Company Owned by Bee and Hornick (Bee owns equipment, Hornick owns land) 1115 East Hickory Street, Streator

Floor is about 2" black slaty coal - below that miner reports 5-6' green shale, then a clay.

Coal is hard, very few impurities, some pyrite on joint faces - 2" charcoal, locally bone, parting near middle: mostly bright coal.
