18' overburden - 6' shale, rest gravel

Spring Lake Coal Company

Owned by Bee and Hornick (Bee owns equipment, Hornick owns land)

1115 East Hickory Street, Streator

Floor is about 2" black slaty coal - below that miner reports 5-6' green shale, then a clay.

Coal is hard, very few impurities, some pyrite on joint faces - $\frac{1}{2}$ " charcoal, locally bone, parting near middle; mostly bright coal.
