A ① yellow to red brown weathered big blocks of limestone fusilinas mostly fat kind-- but some long ones; many small ones in some places mixed with big ones--Some horizons thicker with fusilinas than others-- believed to be Piasa Limestone

Shaft about 11 feet or 16 feet above water in Hodges creek up big trip.

Shaft is 14 feet deep--to bottom of coal Probably a lower coal than the one in foregoing section and probably #6 with #7 above; Another old shaft or working at about same elevation as top of coal outcrop in runlet bank.

Coal reported 3 feet, 6 inches thick
