Old shaft. Estimated elevation 560'. Depth 30' approximately according to Mr. Beckman. 560' - 30' = 530'. Black "slate" in place in stream valley ca. 500' NW of old house. Valley N. from house is in till which contains some broken pieces of the "slate". Pennsylvanian shale extends 100' or 200' S. of fence line (section line). Mississippian rocks to bridge and E. 150'. No more outcrop to Mauvais Terre (700' from bridge).
