



## FIELD NOTES



.h23 Sec.36-9S-4E, Williamson County. Harr.4, July 8, R-29 Near NW corner NE/4, NE/4 Sec.36.

> Get long abandoned strip pit. Top of limestone about 510+ . Coal probably about 500. Some of pit does not seem to have limestone over it ( which top?)

.fg23 ST-30 Near SE corner NE/4, NE/4 Sec 36 From road up to EW 1/4 line get same laminated shale seen on other side of road in gully. But at this place the strata for about 25 feet rise sharply 459 to W. dip E and are much crumpled , including mass crumpled coal and then # 5a goes along horizontally.
