


- Abandoned coal mine dump, nearly hidden in dense .1b bramble patch. No shaft discovered, no outcrops near. Probably a shaft mine.
- .3e East bank of creek shows 15' sandstone cliff. (Other similar, smaller exposures occur downstream)

This looks like Carbondale, although it was originally colored in as Pottsville. for no visible reason. 7/30/27

The sandstone is yellow, friable, locally very shaly, intricately crossbedded; One channel deposit is visible. Micaceous. Thin-bedded (especially where shaly) to rather massive.
