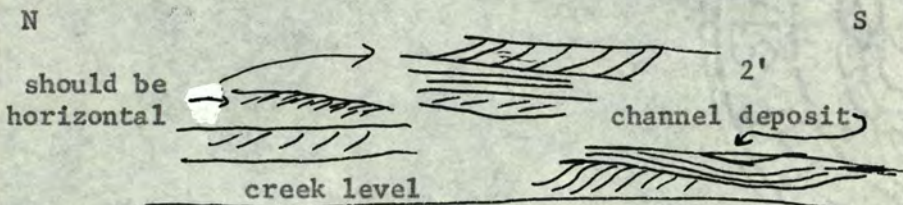
.1b **Abandoned coal mine dump**, nearly hidden in dense bramble patch. No shaft discovered, no outcrops near. **Probably a shaft mine.** #2

.3e East bank of creek shows 15' sandstone cliff.
(Other similar, smaller exposures occur downstream)

This looks like
Carbondale, al-
though it was or-
iginally colored
in as Pottsville,
for no visible
reason. 7/30/27

The sandstone is yellow, friable, locally very shaly, intricately cross-bedded; One channel deposit is visible. Micaceous. Thin-bedded (especially where shaly) to rather massive.
