Abandoned strip mine

Sandstone	about 4-5'
Coal (Dekoven)	about 1'10"
Bone coal or slate	4" -6"
Underclay	about 1'10"
Coal	about 1'2"
Underclay -	barely shows

At north side of stripping apparently 6'-8' below

the coal listed above is an exposure of about 30 inches very much jointed coal.- fine joints bearing more or less NW-SE - looks like bedding as though the coal was vertical - but banding is horizontal. No consecutive exposure between the two coals. This is probably the Davis bed.

A drill hole at NE corner (United Electric) said to be 28' to coal. No log. More or less hearsay evidence.
