
## FIELD NOTES

Wednesday August 17, 1932

Location of shafts and slopes of Wallace Coal Co. Present slope mine - Sec. 4-9S-3E

700' west of angling road in SE/4, Sec. 4 and west of railroad.

and 1050' approximately south of junction of road and railroad

> Slope goes down to east with tipple right at railroad.

Old West Virginia Coal Co mine now abandoned and torn down

Located as shown by topographic map 2100' from east line, 3500' from south line, Sec. 5 9S-3E

Old Henderson-Wallace mine, Sec. 8-9S-3E 55' west of road and 3175' north of southeast section corner - huge hole in ground indicates where shaft was - concrete piers show where tipple stood just south of shaft hole.

Henderson-Wallace Slope Mine Sec. 8-9S-3E Located just east of Marion and Johnston City Railroad in side which slopes west toward railroad embankment. Is located approximately 3050' north of south section line or about 175' of old shaft mine at east side of Sec. 8.

Called on Mr. McLaren but he had gone to Pyalt to be back after lunch probably.
