Outcrop limestone in creek bed. 4' thick exposed  
and 150' long, fine grained, dense (lithographic)  
pale buff and almost white oolitic!!  
characteristic. 1000' to road corner.

Floor of limestone in creek 470' from corner.

Coal digging 850' up stream from house 2½' coal  
overlain by black slate. Top of coal is 10'  
above creek bed.

At 11 a.m. met A.W. Plushnick, USGS topographer who  
is now staying at Chapin c/o Bobbitt's Road  
Commissioner. He is working the southern part  
of the Arenzville quadrangle for which Walker  
ran the primary levels.
