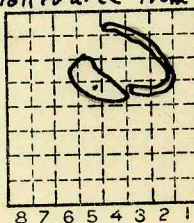

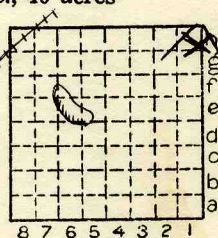

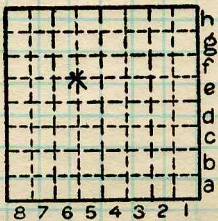

STRIP PIT OF MORGAN COAL CO., INDIANAPOLIS

Pit mainly in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, sec 16, T19 N, R12 W

Cover over coal 8'-15'

Mainly river silt and gravel. Rock over coal as well as coal has been eroded by Salt Fork.

Coal thickness varies: 12" to 72". Thought to be completely eroded in some parts of bottom.

Character of coal: Mainly wet and soft. Some parts close to river considerably weathered and rusty; coal breaks up into small fragments, with very small percentage of lump coal.

Coal close to bluff is harder and of fair quality.

Stripping equipment: One 2-yd dragline for cover over coal.

Loading equipment: One $\frac{3}{4}$ yd Koering gasoline shovel.

No tippie equipment: load directly into trucks which drive down into pit to loading shovel.

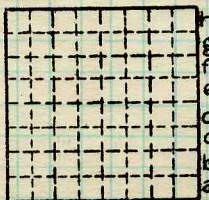
