This is definitely Pennsylvanian; blue clay with .4h coal above. Coal has been worked in several small pits near the junction of these two branches.

Halfway between .5b and.4h there is another small pit in clay, probably also a coal exploration. (or this may be one of the early Cheltenham clay pit) J.R.V.P., Jr. August 5, 1953

Elevation - by map, junction is 575' base of No. 2 ca 577'
