


## FIELD NOTES





T 95 R 2E

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Old shaft of Spillerton Coal and Coke Company (Goodall mine)

Old shaft about 150' west of house north of Spillerton shaft. Old slope directly west of road ending at south side of east section line of Sec. 1.

Wilson Coal Company - Shaft mine to No. 5 coal Location in old strip pit about 400' east of hard road and 500° northeast at 30° angle with house south of main office and scales.

Depth to base of No. 5 coal 58', thickness = 4'0" (coal No. 6 stripped here so base of coal is approximately present surface.

Wilson Coal Company - Slope Mine to No. 6 Coal Depth to coal at slope south = 41, thickness =  $7\frac{1}{2}$ Located on southwest slope of hill, slope in toward northeast.

Local mine north of Hamilton Coal Strip just south of section line - formerly Whiteside Mine GCR 583, depth to coal at slope 18 averages about 8'0" thick.
