

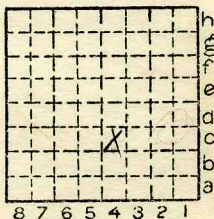

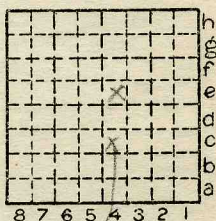

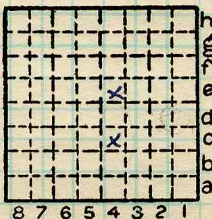

Mr. Steve Dyskiewicz of Danville (217/446-4897, located E of HW 150, just N of I 74, about 200-300 yds E of 150, on property about 800 ft in length, near center of S. 17, in SE (or SW?) 1/4) reported "several sink holes, very distinct & swampy have developed in his back yard." A Mr. (Dr.?)

Smith of ANLRC visited and confirmed them as "definitely" sink holes above an abd. mine.

Mr. D. reported "another" sink hole had developed on highway itself. Also about 8-10 yrs. ago a "methane explosion" happened at an old shaft that broke/fractured windows. This could have been slope entry at c. 4.

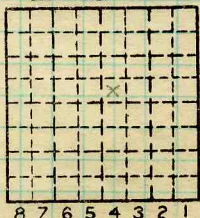
