E1 Corner.

E2 'Slope at outcrop. Coal outcrops around edge of hill to southwest. General Coal Report #482. Woodbridge Mine. Leased from Peabody Coal Co. Coal 9', uses lower 7'. Above coal - 2-3' black slate overlain by decayed limestone like that seen near Spillertown. Haulage by Whiff - 2 cars. Elevation 504 A.T.L.

E3 Small 'slope' outcrop of No.7 coal. Gilford Price and Wm. McGowan Mine. Leased from Peabody. Dip N. Elevation same as E2 504 A.T.L.
(Note. Could not be located on map but probably in this Sec. R.V. 1/68)
(11-9S-2E. 9' of #7. Later note in Cady Notebook #102)

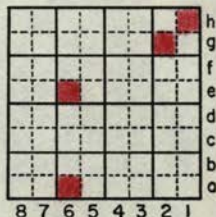
