28' to bottom of sump which is at bottom of under-clay

20' to coal approximately

Over coal is shale, black, and gray - no concretions found as yet.

East of mine right at section line is outcrop of Oak Grove member over Colchester coal with Purington shale over top Oak Grove upstream for 300 yards.

Shale, gray, irregularly bedded, ironstone concretions 20'

Limestone, gray, sandy, thin-slabby bedded, very fossiliferous, micaceous 1'

Shale, gray to dark gray, calcareous, fossiliferous with two 1" fossiliferous limestone bands about 7-8" apart 5'
