- .2c** Ledges of sandy shale and firm sandstone with current ripple marks. Thickest hard layers about 5". Creek bank.
- .3h** Ledges of black slaty shale and fine yellowish gray to gray sandstone. Some of latter is quite limy  
Coal is reported along the creek worked many years ago.
- .2h** Well at house dug 75', drilled lower to 160+. Dug part not in limestone. Probably mainly sandstone and shale. Said to get hard water in limestone.
