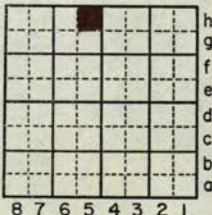

At bottom. General Coal Report #468.

4'+ Fireclay  
4' Coal  
5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' Gray shale  
4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' Black shale  
30' Limestone, top shaly  
2-4' Fireclay  
10' Coal

A few horsebacks or rolls which dip down into coal 1-2'.  
Dip slightly west and north. No props used. No sulphur  
band. Thickness 46". Sample from 1st west off south,  
Room No.3. Main cleat NE-SW?. Capacity 50 tons daily.
