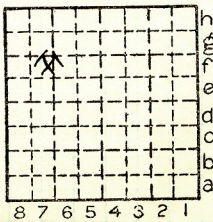

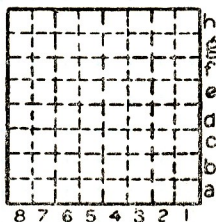
The Old Blue Blaze mine is now the

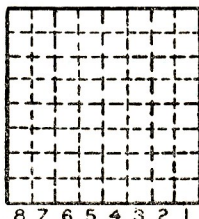

The old Blue Blaze, now the Mayer Coal Co., was 1st operated, as a slope. by Mr. Bowers. Then it was taken over by Harvey Baltz who put in a new slope. Later he tried to strip. The present Mayer Coal Co. is a slope, the entry starting part way down the wall of the old strip pit. From the surface of the ground, above the entry, it is 40 feet to the coal. Coal is 6' to 6'4" thick.
