At head of ravine SW of Cotton house where coal bed has been worked a little Top Sandstone, massive, uneven at base, dip N60°E about 8: 4' Shale, black, fine, fairly hard and fissile in small pieces ca 1'4" Shale, white to gray; upper feet soft but not an underclay ca 4' Shale, dark gray to black, occasional layer soft limonite (ironstone ?) 6" 1'11" *Coal Underclay, gray ca 1'8" Shale, dark brownish, full of Stigmaria, 6" poorly bedded *Shale, black fissils 15" Much decayed, honeycombed material, probably 2" flint 2" Marl-like material, grayish, soft 2" Marl-like material, yelowish Sandstone, shaly, becomes less sandy and more ca 1' 1" like shale ca 1' Concealed Shale, light gray, sandy with small ironstone concretions *Coal Underclay, light greenish gray with yellowish spots ca 1º Sandstone, Stigmaria, poorly exposed 1-2'
