Elevation at mine about	750' \pm 10'
Depth to coal	50'
Elevation of coal	700' \pm 10'
Thickness of coal	4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' to 5'

Have just sunk new shaft here. No log kept but owner reports as follows:

Drift	15'
Sandstone	15'-20'
Blue rock (shale)	10'-15'
Soapstone	15'-20'
Coal	5'
Underclay	

This coal bed has a 2" clay parting somewhere "about the middle of the bed."
