1/7/97 Dwight Cravens, a farmer from the Elkhart area visited the survey to view our mine maps of Logan and Sangamon Counties. He commented that our maps did not show a shaft he knew of at "Mt. Fulcher."

The shaft is located just south of the railroad tracks and east of the road approximately 150' from the south line and 2500 feet from the east line of section 23 Township 18 north Range 4W, Logan County.

According to Mr. Cravens, the shaft was dug to the coal, but abandoned because of the volume of water flowing into the shaft from the drift. The shaft was dug in 1910.
