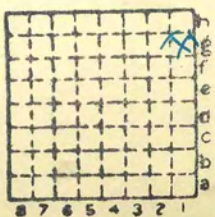

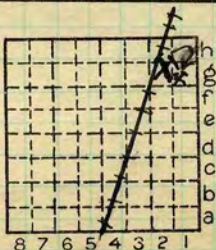

1905 Coal Report

The Illinois Collieries Co., Chicago, (Railway Exchange Bldg.) has bought the Chicago-Virden Coal Co.'s mines Nos. 1, 2 and 3, also the Virden Coal Co.'s shaft, all at Virden, Macoupin county. This company has also bought the Girard Coal Co.'s shaft at Girard, the Jones and Adams Coal Co.'s shaft at Springfield, and the Litchfield Mining and Power Co's shaft at Litchfield. These several mines will be known as No. 1 at North Virden, No. 2 at Auburn, No. 3 at Chatam, No. 4 at South Virden, No. 5 at Girard, No. 7 at Litchfield, and No. 8 at Springfield.

J. P. Gorden of Salisbury, Sangamon county, has sold his shaft to W. U. Whitehurst.
