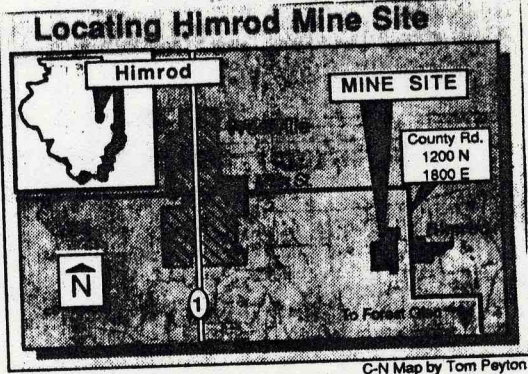

SPRINGFIELD - About \$34,000 will be spent to reclaim the abandoned Himrod Coal Co. No. 46 mine in Vermillion County, Ill. Gov. George Ryan announced Wednesday.

C and V Erectors Inc. of Danville, the contractor for the project, expects to begin work within a month on the mine, located about 1.5 miles east of Westville, and finish this fall.

Problems at the mine center on a 15-foot refuse pile spread over about 1.5 acres. Acid runoff and sedimentation from the pile are affecting nearby land, including a pasture.

The mine site also contains a



cement capped mine shaft and scattered foundations from old buildings.

Kim St. Aubin, spokesman for the Abandoned Mined Lands Reclamation Council, said the project calls for the refuse pile to be treated with limestone to neutralize the acid, then be buried under

a layer of soil, graded and seeded.

The shaft will be excavated and filled, St. Aubin said. At the same time, the old foundation will be demolished and removed.

Ryan, chairman of the council, said the Vermillion County mine reclamation project is one of five now getting under way

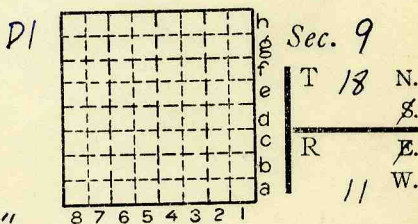

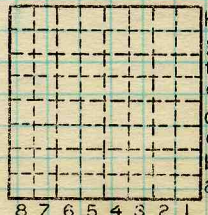

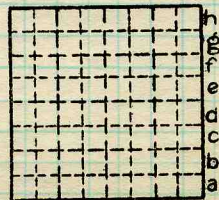
