Instead of attempting to show the many local variations of roof as seen at this mine it was decided to show one sketch and incorporate the various examples of sections.

A - A light grey unfossil. non-concret. shale soft and weak. normally not over 2" thick but in one place observed (in main S.) to be ± 36" thick.

B. Hornf. black slate - firm and sound some slips and quite a few concretions in the lower zone. 0-20"

C. Well bedded grey shale - Sampled
Appearance to be minusc. grey slate. 0-20"
Quite a lot of carbonaceous remains.

D. Limestone. 0-15"



him Sept. points out that if the coal is allowed to be exposed to stagnant air. Some sort of reaction takes place where the coal begins to swell and heat.

Swelling is indicated by the way it pushes and breaks down top.

Heat is indicated by the way it will fire coal in old works - In one case it found a high ridge on some 30' above the top of the #6.

Depth to coal here is 250'.




