Revive coal mining industry in county



A formerly important industry for this area is now being revived, modernized and enlarged.

Located only a short distance southeast of the New Salem State Park is the coal mine formerly known as the H. B. Wilson Mine.

Due to reasons of ill health Mr. Wilson sold this mine at public auction last November. It was purchased by Donald Piper of Greenfield, who is actively engaged in coal and rock mining in Green County.

Ira E. Theobald, formerly of Flora, but now a resident of Petersburg, who has been active in Illinois, Indiana and Kentucky oil and gas well development, and

farm and other real estate sales and operation for over 35 years, became interested in the coal and mineral possibilities of Menard and surrounding counties. After checking available State Geological Reports he contacted Mr. Piper regarding the Wilson mine, and was able to interest several Kentucky, Southern Illinois and local individuals on the formation of the New Salem Mining Corporation, incorporated for the purpose of developing coal, oil and other mineral properties in the Central Illinois area.

The officers of this Corporation are: Pres. C. M. (Jack) Heap, Oil Producer of Olney; Vice-Pres.

Charles R. Theobald, International Harvester Dealer of Williamsville, Sec., Ira E. Theobald, Petersburg; Treas. Donald Piper, Greenfield.

These men have employed experienced mine operators and managers, cleaned up the mine, purchased additional modern mine equipment, and will soon be producing large quantities of high grade coal for local and contract customers.

They extend cordial invitations to the public to drive out to the mine and inspect its operations.

The above photo was taken Monday morning. Later photos will show the new mining equipment when it arrives.



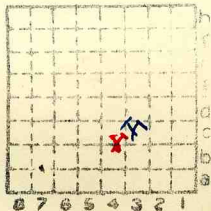
