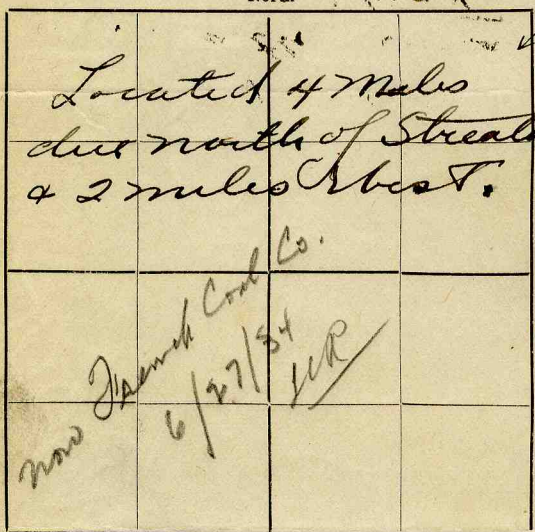

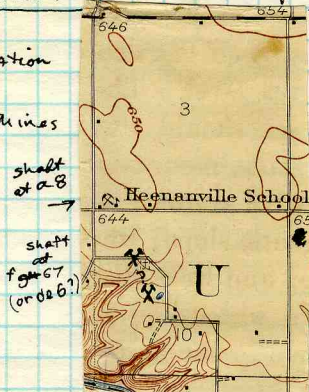
K.—ACTIVE SHIPPING OR LOCAL COAL MINE.

There is much confusion about how many + where this coal co. had mines. (See McCabe Card.) After examining all available data I arrived at the following list.

1. There is a H-ville Mine in (or very near) Section 3+10 T31N R3E. The original entry for this mine gives no T.R or section location, but states location as "4 miles due north of Streator and 2 miles west" There is no Heensville, but there is a H-ville School (see below) at precisely this location. The shaft at aB is not part of the French Coal Co. (or map 5) by our location of their shaft (b6) and there is probably a Heensville Mine \oplus
2. There is a second H-ville mine at fgh 67, sec 10 T31N, R3E in operation in 1917. This is an earlier location than f7 or e7 + appears to be in same handwriting as original entry for the first mine. (above). Location of d26 given by Cady on map 4102
15.1-83 this is prob. the older mine.
3. There may be a mine at 7-31E-4E, but there is no record of any operations in this area, or of the 1924 source of info mentioned on McCabe Card. (No entry has ^{been} kept in Mine Notes. for this location)

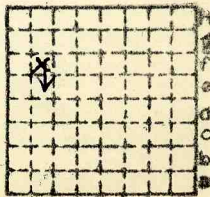
