Donally - Koenecke Coal Company

Permanently abandoned

SW/4, NW/4, Sec. 26-8S-1E

Levelled from USGS BM at northeast corner Sec. 3-9S-1E

Elevation of hoist shaft (ground at edge of old shaft hole) = 402.0

Sunrise Coal Company

Slope mine (active) southeast corner southwest corner Sec. 33-8S-1E

Levelled from USGS BM at Northeast corner Sec. 3-9S-1E

Elevation of ground immediately above slope entrance = 455.1

Depth to top of coal 54' - coal averages 9-10' thick

Sampson Mine

Shaft mine (permanently abandoned) shaft filled up; Northeast corner NW/4, Sec. 4-9S-1E

Levelled from U.S.G.S. BM at northeast corner of Sec. 3-9S-1E

Elevation of ground at north side of depressions where shaft was = 450.1

Depth to top of coal = 47', average thickness = 9'
