"Horseback in roof and coal, Lakeside Coal Company mine near Pekin, Illinois."

This photograph was found in June 1976 among other photographs and notes of Heinz Damberger, who had already left the Survey at this time. Reproductions of this photo were found in a notebook (HHD, Clastic Dikes, Ms.) also among Damberger's effects he left behind. No clues were found as to the date or origin of this photo. It could not have been taken by Damberger, who was not even in this country until the late 60's, and the Lakeside Mine closed in 1955. Possibly the photo was taken by George Wilson whose notes here indicate "Many horsebacks in this mine."
