Old wagon mine on inner edge of terrace.

Siltstone--light gray to light tan, mica-
ceous, medium-bedded. exposed 5'

Coal. 3 1/2'

7c Towards head of ravine--siltstone.

7c Coal mine.

In "cave-ins" below mine shaft there is
exposed 3-6' of the light gray to tan
siltstone.

The coal level is approximately that of the
inner edge of terrace.

7a West side Vermilion River.

Coal--with thin, fissile shale partings. 4' 6"

Clay--black, coaly. 7"

Clay--light gray to gray. 1' 6"

Clay--gray, ironstone concretions. exposed 6'

Covered to river. 15'

Note--40' downstream a massive sandstone
outcrops at river edge and shows 5' vertical
outcrop.

7a Just downstream from mouth of ravine on west side
of river.

Sandstone--massive, brown, a little micaceous,
exposed at river edge. 4'
