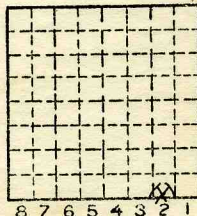

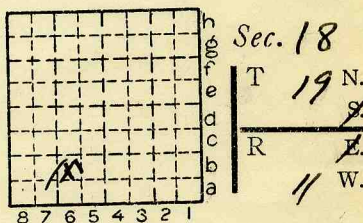

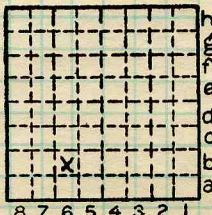

## Elsworth Coal Company - Shaft No. 4

1883 coal report states that a hole was drilled to the lower No. 2 ~~vein~~ vein. This is the Sedgsville. It further states that a shaft was sunk to this coal in the same year. The 1884 reports mention a coal at a depth of 303 feet at a thickness of 3' 8". The 1885 report says that shaft was sunk to this seam at depth of 310 <sup>in 1883</sup> ~~feet~~ that it was abandoned in 1885 because of poor quality. Probably because the Sedgsville in this area of Vermilion County is split by several prominent shale partings. Mining continued in #7 Coal at 71 feet instead ~~of~~

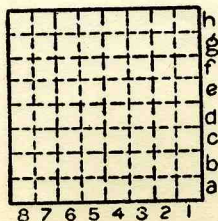
