A shaft more than 400' deep was dug some time in the late 1800's. The shaft was unnamed and the driller unknown. No #6 coal was found. It was open for several years, and covered with a timber platform and dirt.

In September, 1969, the top collapsed and left a 400° deep hole just southwest of Highway 48, on the shoulder. The hole was filled in. Circular #314 indicates this shaft is in the #6 out area.
