




Notes - Old Illinois Survey on Western Counties

On Coal Creek at Fullers Coal bank near center of south part, section 30, T 14, R 10, 15' light grayish (shaly?) limestone said to be exposed. (near Woodson ? on C & A about 9 miles southwest Jacksonville). Probably not well situated for quarry.



October 4, 1927 40' Pleistocene section in cut bank:



Foot traverse down to 1425.23c (stream junction) then E. up smaller stream to 1430.3a. Bed in till all the way. Inquired of several farmers if any coal diggings in vicinity. All say no; the nearest is on the hard road (Big Sandy Mining Co.). Evidently the location given in the Worthen Report is wrong. Instead of T 14 N, it should read T 13 N. Fuller's coal bank is therefore near the present Fisher mine Section checks pretty well.
