



FIELD NOTES





In gully, old drift mine showing coal no.2? underlying a massive sandstone. Altitude of base of coal about 430±. Possibly upper level # 2.


Massive sandstone below the coal along valley bluff at south of valley and along road.

coal at least 33" thick. Total thickness not
shown seems about = - .Sandstone above at least
6 feet thick.

.c8 L-22, In next gully;

Sandstone not so well exposed and two beds unidentifiable. No coal shows. Upper material sandy loess like covering. Not typical till, thin 5' maximum.

Ledge of sandstone has been dug under here about 405 at top. Coal if present not above 400 at base.
