$\frac{1}{2}$ mile east Petersbug, Route 43a.

East bluff Sangamon valley, deep road cut.

5-6' leached buff loess.

6' calcareous fossiliferous buff loess.

6'± leached brown loess.

3-4' weathered drift--gumbo-like in some places.

45'± calcareous till with gravel layer through the middle 5-6' thick.

Fine spring on the gravel layer beside the road.

Mine on valley wall suggest Pennsylvanian not far below exposed till.
