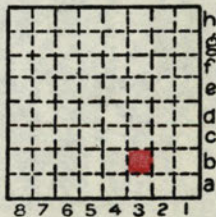

Shale outcrop along creek, branch. The shale is micaceous, like some forms in Clay County, and is overlaid by massive limestone. Beneath shale, at about 40' is a 4' vein of coal. Several coal mines are in the vicinity, one being a strip mine at 0602.61 (Sec. 2-30N-3E, .3b), where a 4'-5' vein of good coal containing some pyrite lenses is overlaid by 8'-12' of silty till.
